INDUSTRIES-Small Scale Industries-Third Five Year Plan - Scheme for the establishment of Industrial Estates, Worksheds, and Doveloped Plots - Sanctioned.

Read the following:

From the Director of Industries and Commerce letter No.W. 191096/SIA1/60 d.ted 12.10.1960.

ORDER:

The Director of Industries and Commerce submitted a scheme with his letter read above, for the establishment of Industrial estates, worksheds and developed plots as detailed below:

I. Worksheds in places with population upto 5000:

Number of worksheds.

- 1. Tiruchirapalli District for synthetic Stone workers.
- 2. Tirunelveli District for Carpentry and Blacksmithy.

(at Rs. 10,000 each)

II. Industrial Estates in places with popplation upto 20000:

One Estate at Tirumanagalam (Madurai District at Rs.5,37,430 (since changed to Theni).

Estate for Ceramic Industry at Vridhachalam, South Arcot District at Rs. 32,77,994.

III. Industrial Estates in places with population upto 50000:

Five Estates at Pudukottai (Tiruchirapalli District). Karaikudi (Ramanathapuram District). Arkonam (North Arcot District). Koilpatti (Tirunelveli District) . Villupuram (South Aucot District) (since changed to Krishnagiri in North Salem) at Rs. 9,69,070 each.

IV. Industrial Estates in places with population upto 1 lakh:

Two Estates each at Tuticorin (Tirunelveli District) and Dindigul (Madurai) District at Rs.15,90,690 each.

V. Industrial Estates in places with population over 1 lakh:

One Estate at ambattur at Rs.1, 18, 16, 122. One Estate for Leather Goods. and Footwear at Perambur. at Rs. 11,84,930

VI. Developed Sites:

354 acres of Developed Plots at Guindy. 330 acres of developed sites at Ambattur. at Rs.69,85,000 The estimated cost involved in the proposal is Rs. 4,90,900 recurring per annum and Rs.31,14,26,500 non-recurring. During 1961-62, a dia non-recurring expenditure of Rs. 98,80,000 only is proposed to be incurred. The scheme has been included in Draft Third Five (Year Plan. The entire expenditure on the scheme will be sanction ask interest bearing loan for from the Government of Indial . The scheme has been monsidered as a Part II scheme for 1961-62. The Government approve the scheme submitted by the Director of Industries and Commerce for the establishment of industrial estates and worksheds and developed plots with the modifications that one of the two estates in places with population upto 20,000 should be located at Theni instead of at Tirumangglam and that one of the five industrial estates to be established in places eith a population between 202 20,000 and 50,000 should be loc ted at Krishnagiri in North Salem instead of at Villupuram. A provision of Rs. 56.46 lakhs has been in the Budget Estimate 1961-62 under the Capital Account.

- 2. Sanction is accorded to a non-recurring expenditure of Rs. 3, 14,500 (Rupees three crores fourteen lakhs twenty six thousand and five hundred only) towards lands, roads, factory buildings, fencing, wax water, power, supply, drainage, machinery and equipment as detailed in Annexure & I to this order. The expenditure should be incurred only after 1.4.1961.
- 3. Sanction is accorded to a recurring expenditure of Rs. 2,21,000 (Rupees two lakhs and twenty one thousand only) towards contingencies, electric charges, rent, rates and taxes and consumable stores as detailed in Annexure II to this order. No recurring expenditure should, however, be incurred during 1961-62.
- 4. The Government sanction the employment of the staff whown in Annexure III to this order. The staff should be employed only during 1962-63 as and when necessary.

The staff will be eli_ible to draw the usual dearness and other allowances admissible under the rules.

The Director is requested to submit in due course, draft ad hoc rules regulating the conditions of the service of the staff sanctioned above, wherever necessary.

of account "Establishment of Industrial Estates Worksheds and Developed Plots" to be opened under "43. Industries and Supplies-J. Development schemes - schemes in the Third Five Year Plan (i) Industries". The non-recurring expenditure should be debited to Industries". The non-recurring expenditure should be debited to "82. Capital Account of other works outside the Revenue Account - IV. Development schemes - schemes in the Third Five Year Plan - (ii) Suspense and Miscellaneous-B. Industries - XXXIV. Industrial Estates, Worksheds and Developed Plots". The loan from the Government of India as and when received should be credited to "N. Public Debts - III. Loans from the Government of India - Loans for Small Scale Industries".

No expenditure should however be incurred before 1.4.1961 based on this sanction.

6. The Director of Industries and Commerce is informed that in constructing the Units in Industrial Estates, a beginning should be put-up-according to the actual that additional units should be put up according to the actual demand so as to ensure that units are not kept idle for want of occupants.

- 7. The Director of Industries and Commerce is requested to submit trgently necessary proposals in the prescribed proforma together with lay out planes for the estates, for addressing the Development Commissioner, SmallScale Industries, New Delhi for according technical approval to the Scheme.
- 8. The Director of Industries and Commerce is requested to include the expenditure in the quarterly statements of expenditure to be submitted to the Government of India and the Planning Commission with reference to para 6 of the Government memorandum no. 54538 Plg./58-2 Finance dated 23.5.1958 and see that the loan from the Government of India is received and credited to the accounts of this Government.
- 9. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O.No.404 P & D II/61-1 dated 3.3.1961.
